Ms. Leung is a Certified Medical Physicist. Having served in Queen Mary Hospital and Prince of Wales Hospital in the 1980's, she joined the Department of Clinical Oncology of Tuen Mun Hospital in 1990, and is currently the Senior Physicist of Tuen Mun Hospital and Radiation Protection Advisor of the New Territories West Cluster, Hong Kong SAR.

She obtained her BSc Biology & Physics (Biophysics) from King's College, University of London, UK in 1979, and MSc Applied Radiation Physics from University of Birmingham, UK in 1980.

Ms. Leung is a prominent figure in the field of Medical Physics. She has many professional affiliations both in Hong Kong and overseas. In the Hong Kong Association of Medical Physics (HKAMP), she was President from 2006 – 2013, and Member of the Association's Examination Committee from 2005-2013, leading the Committee as Chairperson from 2007-2009. She is a Member of Institute of Physics & Engineering in Medicine, United Kingdom (IPEM), American Association of Physicists in Medicine (AAPM), British Institute of Radiology (BIR), American Society for Radiation Oncology (ASTRO) and Hong Kong Radiation Protection Society. She was Founder Member of the Hong Kong Society of Nuclear Medicine (HKSNM) in 1985.

She is a leading physicist in hospital development planning for Radiology and Medical Physics services. In the past 17 years, she had assisted in the planning of the establishment of Radiotherapy Centre at Princess Margaret Hospital (1998-2006), Radiology & Medical Physics Services in Pok Oi Hospital Redevelopment & Expansion Project (2000-2006), and also participated in the planning of Radiology & Medical Physics services in Tin Shui Wai Hospital from 2000 until now.

Ms. Leung is also committed to education and healthcare development. Having the expertise in radiation protection, she was Member of the Radiological Advisory Group of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region from 2007 to 2015, and the Task Force on Radiation Detection and Measurement of the Hong Kong Accreditation Service from 2011 to 2014. She had been an invited speaker to deliver a lecture on "Radiation Protection in Medicine" and a panel member in the Public Forum on "Clinical Information on Radiation and Radiation Protection Symposium: From Evidence to Actions" at the 5th Congress of the Asian Society of Cardiovascular Imaging (ASCI 2011) in June 2011.

Ms. Leung has been supporting the Hong Kong College of Radiologists from the early days of our inception. She regularly teaches Physics to Resident Physicists and our College's trainees for more than 30 years since 1983. She taught in our College's training courses in all 3 specialties including Radiology, Clinical Oncology and Nuclear Medicine from 1990 to 2012. She served the College as Member of the Preparatory Subcommittee for the Fellowship Examination in Nuclear Medicine in 1995 and the Training and Examination Subcommittee in Nuclear Medicine from 1999 to 2013. She had been the Examiner in numerous occasions in the First Fellowship Examination in Nuclear Medicine for over 17 years from 1995 to 2012. In addition to teaching and serving as examiner, Ms. Leung also assisted the College as external assessor in the training accreditation visits of training centres for Clinical Oncology (2012), Palliative Medicine (2012) and Nuclear Medicine (2010). She contributed immensely in our training programme and gives her expert advice generously.
