INTRODUCTION

This is the instruction for the preparation of abstracts for the BME2014 Proceedings. English is the official language. Please do not forget to check the spelling. Read the instructions in this sample carefully before typing. The abstract should be prepared using MS Word. The authors must strictly adhere to the instructions for preparation of the abstract. BME2014 3-day Conference will be held during 4-6 December 2014 in Hong Kong. All abstracts for BME2014 must be submitted electronically by 30 September 2014. More details can be found in the official website <http://www.bme2014.wix/bme2014>.

All abstracts must be submitted as PDF file and files should not be larger than 4 MB. Abstracts that meet standards of acceptability will be included in the printed Conference proceedings.

METHODS

The abstract is limited to one A4 size page (210x297mm), with two columns of text, justified. Left and right margins should be 15 mm, top and bottom 20 mm. Type font is Times New Roman or Times Roman 10 pt. It is best if abstracts are formatted using this document as a template. Please do not change formatting within the template document, as this may cause problems when including abstracts in the printed proceedings. The Conference organization reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not adhere to the formatting guidelines in this document.

The title (in bold caps), authors, and author affiliations should be centered across the top of the page. Use numerical superscripts to distinguish authors from different institutions. An email address of the corresponding author should be included. A web address of department, laboratory or author may be included if desired.

The body of the manuscript should be divided into sections specifically titled as follows: Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion, and Conclusions (optional). Text within each section should be fully justified, without paragraph indentations. Leave a blank line between paragraphs.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Figures and tables may be incorporated within the document and must be referenced in the text (Figure 1). Captions must be legible and placed below each Figure, and above each Table. Tables may extend across two columns when needed (Table 1). Use "Format -> Columns" to control which parts

of the text are in single column format.

Reference citations within the text are to be made with numbers [1,2]. References are to be formatted as illustrated on this page. Place the journal or book title in Italics, with volume numbers in bold [3].

Abstracts for BME2014 must be submitted electronically by email to bme2014@hkpc.org by 30 September 2014. Authors will be notified of acceptance by 1 November 2014. All accepted papers will be considered for the Awards of Best Student Papers Competition.
